



## Education in Cuba February 20 to February 27 – Preliminary Program

*The estimated cost of the program is \$2150 in double occupancy and \$2350 in single occupancy, including accommodations at 4\* hotels, breakfast daily, 2 additional meals, farewell party, transportation by airconditioned bus, English speaking guide, entry visa, medical/evacuation insurance, program of interviews, meetings, talks and visits to facilitate research. RT air Miami/Havana included; option for flights JFK/Havana for additional \$450.*
